

Aussie Telco Supports Rural & Remote Aussies with Royal Flying Doctor Service Giveback Scheme

Australian owned-and-operated satellite internet provider Activ8me has announced they will be donating to the Royal Flying Doctor Service for every new customer who connects their Sky Muster satellite service with them, as part of the company's ongoing efforts to support rural and remote Australians.

The giveback scheme will see \$2 per month – for the first 12 months of a new customer's active account – donated to support the work of the Royal Flying Doctor Service, Australia's largest aeromedical organisation.
