RFDS clinics hooked up

IN THE last three months. Aussie Telco Activ8me has connected 14 new Royal Flying Doctor Service Primary Health Clinics across country Queensland to high-speed Satellite broadband internet.

The new clinics in Gregory Downs, Adels Grove, Croydon, Einasleigh, Pentland, Chillagoe, Greenvale, Dajarra and Urandangi offer GP consultations, immunisations, peri and post-natal care, and assistance with health conditions.

These clinics operate on a fly-in-fly-out basis, either weekly, fortnightly or monthly.

When RFDS doctors and specialists fly to the clinic and conduct consultations with patients they are now able to access online the most up-to-date patient records, and also other online health resources, or consult other specialist in the city via video link.

A further ten sites - at Bedourie, Birdsville, Boulia, Bourketown, Camooweal, Doomadgee, Eulo, Mornington Island, Stonehenge and Yaraka - are being considered for new connections in late 2019.
